

CALIFORNIA AB1200 DISCLOSURE

California Law AB1200 requires cookware manufactures to disclose on their website any intentionally added chemicals listed on the [California DTSC Candidate Chemical List](#), which may be present on any cookware surface that comes into contact with food or in the handle of the product. We have chosen to also disclose the listed chemicals that may be present in the substrate layers beneath the food-contact surface. The presence of these chemicals does not mean that our cookware, bakeware, or appliances will pose a health risk with normal use.
